State of Connecticut Litchfield County Ss on this 25th day of April AD 1818 before me Augustus Pettibone Chief Judge of the County Court for said Litchfield County which is a Court of record personally appeared Isaac Allen of Norfolk in Litchfield County and State aforesaid aged sixty three years who being by me first duly sworn according to law doth on his oath make the following Decleration in order to obtain the provision made by the late act of Congress entitled an Act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land and navel service of the United State in the revolutionary war – That the said Isaac Allen enlisted at fort Stanwick [sic: Fort Stanwix] on the Mohawk river in the State of New York (where he then was a Soldier) in the month of March 1777 for During the war in the Company Commanded by Jeremiah Parmeter in the Continental regement so Cald Commanded by Colo Moses Hazen Capt Parmeter soon died and the Company was Commanded by Capt. James Duncan in which Company and regement I served untill the Close of the war in the service of the United States when he was Honorably Discharged in the State of New Jersey he was in Brandewine Battell [sic: Brandywine, 11 Sep 1777] Germantown Battell [4 Oct 1777] a Battell on Straton Iland [sic: Staten Island NY, 21 Aug 1777] was at Yorktown at the takeing of Cornwallis and his Army [19 Oct 1781] He was in the service of his Country before he enlisted as above one year and seven month and when he received his Discharge at the Close of the war he was Honored with the Badge of Honor for six years faithfull Service – which Discharge is lost or Destroid - And that he is in reduced Circumstances and stands in need of assistance from his Country for support
