

Southern Campaign American Revolution Pension Statements & Rosters

Pension Application of Robert Dugar S39465 VA
Transcribed and annotated by C. Leon Harris.

At a Court of Quarterly session held for King William county at the Courthouse on Monday the 24th of May 1819–

Robert Dugar a resident of this County aged sixty six years this day came into court who being first duly sworn according to law doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the provision made by the late act of Congress entitled, “An act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land and naval service of the United States in the revolutionary war” – That he the said Ro Dugar enlisted for the term of two years on the [blank] day January 1776 in King William County, State of Virginia, in the Company commanded by Captain Holt Richeson, of the Regiment commanded by Colonel McClanahan [sic: Alexander McClenachan] in the line of the State of Virginia on the Continental establishment, that he continued to serve in the said corps or in the service of the United States until the [blank] day of February 1781 [sic], when he was discharged from service at Vally Forge [sic: Valley Forge, encampment for the winter of 1777-78] in the State of Pennsylvania; that he was in the battles of German Town [Germantown 4 Oct 1777] and Savannah [see endnote], and that he is in reduced circumstances and stands in need of the assistance of his Country for support & that he has no other evidence now in his power of his said services.


