Goochland County } On this 20th day of August 1832 personally appeared before the County Court of Goochland in the state of Virginia being a court of record Benjamin Woodward a resident of said County & state aforesaid aged seventy three years in October last who being first duly sworn according to law doth on his oath make the following Declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the provision made by the Act of Congress passed June 7th 1832

That he enlisted in the Army of the United States in the year 1776 for the term of two years with Lieutenant Nathaniel Morris [Nathaniel G Morris, pension application S36178], a recruiting Officer, and served in the Ninth Virginia Regiment of the Continental line under the following named officers Colonel Thomas Fleming, Colo. Matthews [sic: George Mathews], Major Ennis [sic: James Innes], Captain Samuel Woodson, Lieutenant Nathaniel Morris, Lieutenant Robert Woodson, Ensign Wm Holman [William Holman], Ensign Joseph Payne, & General Muhlenburg [sic: Peter Muhlenberg], in General Greene's Division, that he left the service in 1778, that he enlisted in the County of Goochland aforesaid in which he resided when he entered the service, that he was in the battle at Brandywine [11 Sep 1777], and marched through the states of Maryland, Pennsylvania, Delaware, New Jersey & New York – he hereby relinquishes every claim whatever to a pension or an Annuity except the present, and he declares that his name is not on the pension roll of any agency in any state Sworn to and subscribed the day and year aforesaid Benjamin hisXmark Woodward
