
Note: Unfortunately the documents posted online relating to Thomas Collins are mostly illegible as they are very faint. I can make out an attestation by the veteran that reads as follows:

Thomas Collins being Duly Sworn before me declares that the above Account is Just & that he has not Received any Part thereof.

S/ Wm H. Hills, JP 3rd April 1779

I can partially make out a document which appears to be an attestation by Colonel George Hicks that Thomas Collins served under his command in an expedition to some Bay. This document appears to be dated in 1779. The signature of Colonel Hicks can be made out and appears as follows:

S/ Geo. Hicks Colo.

A handwritten signature in cursive script, which appears to read "Geo. Hicks Colo." The signature is written in dark ink and is somewhat faded and difficult to read. It is positioned below the typed name "S/ Geo. Hicks Colo." and is partially obscured by a horizontal line.
