[Methodology: Spelling, punctuation and/or grammar have been corrected in some instances for ease of reading and to facilitate searches of the database. Where the meaning is not compromised by adhering to the spelling, punctuation or grammar, no change has been made. Corrections or additional notes have been inserted within brackets or footnotes. Blanks appearing in the transcripts reflect blanks in the original. A bracketed question mark indicates that the word or words preceding it represent(s) a guess by me. The word 'illegible' or 'indecipherable' appearing in brackets indicates that at the time I made the transcription, I was unable to decipher the word or phrase in question. Only materials pertinent to the military service of the veteran and to contemporary events have been transcribed. Affidavits that provide additional information on these events are included and genealogical information is abstracted, while standard, 'boilerplate' affidavits and attestations related solely to the application, and later nineteenth and twentieth century research requests for information have been omitted. I use speech recognition software to make all my transcriptions. Such software misinterprets my southern accent with unfortunate regularity and my poor proofreading skills fail to catch all misinterpretations. Also, dates or numbers which the software treats as numerals rather than words are not corrected: for example, the software transcribes "the eighth of June one thousand eighty six" as "the 8th of June 1786." Please call material errors or omissions to my attention.]



Know all men by these Presents that I Moses Hays of the State of North Carolina and County of Mecklenburg, have named constituted and by these presents do name ordain and appoint and make Micha Frieman [sic Michael Freeman] my true attorney, for me and in my name, and to my use, to demand, sue for, and Recover, and Receive of the Commissioners of South Carolina, one full Grown Negro (or whatever may be in lieu thereof) Due and Owing to me for my Services done in the said State of South Carolina under General Sumpter [Thomas Sumter] in Colonel Polk's [William Polk's] Regiment and Captain Nathaniel Martin's Troop, allowing all and whatsoever my said attorney shall Lawfully do or have to be done therein, by virtue of these presents. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal Dated this 27th Day December in the year 1786
