[Methodology: Spelling, punctuation and/or grammar have been corrected in some instances for ease of reading and to facilitate searches of the database. Where the meaning is not compromised by adhering to the spelling, punctuation or grammar, no change has been made. Corrections or additional notes have been inserted within brackets or footnotes. Blanks appearing in the transcripts reflect blanks in the original. A bracketed question mark indicates that the word or words preceding it represent(s) a guess by me. The word 'illegible' or 'indecipherable' appearing in brackets indicates that at the time I made the transcription, I was unable to decipher the word or phrase in question. Only materials pertinent to the military service of the veteran and to contemporary events have been transcribed. Affidavits that provide additional information on these events are included and genealogical information is abstracted, while standard, 'boilerplate' affidavits and attestations related solely to the application, and later nineteenth and twentieth century research requests for information have been omitted. I use speech recognition software to make all my transcriptions. Such software misinterprets my southern accent with unfortunate regularity and my poor proofreading skills fail to catch all misinterpretations. Also, dates or numbers which the software treats as numerals rather than words are not corrected: for example, the software transcribes "the eighth of June one thousand eighty six" as "the 8<sup>th</sup> of June 1786." Please call material errors or omissions to my attention.]

**P**URSUANT to an ACT of the General Assembly, passed the 16th of March, 1783, and Resolution passed the 16th December, 1791, I have this Day delivered to

*Isaiiah Baize*

this **INDENTED CERTIFICATE**, for the Sum of *Eighty four Pounds fifteen Shillings Sterling*

*being for the Amount of Pay, balance of Bounty and Extra Allowance due him for Duty in Colonel Wade Hamptons Regiment of Cavalry*

The said *Isaiiah Baize* his Executors, Administrators or Assigns, will be entitled to receive from this State, the Sum of *Eighty four Pounds fifteen Shillings Sterling* bearing Interest thereon, at the rate of seven per cent. per Annum, from the first day of *April 1792*

For the true performance of Payment, the **PUBLIC TREASURY** is made liable, and the **TAXES** of the **STATE** pledged by the aforesaid Act.

**GIVEN** under my Hand at the **TREASURY OFFICE**, in *Charleston* the *Twenty fifth* Day of *JUNE* One Thousand Seven Hundred and *Ninety two*
