

[p 7: Printed form of Indent No. 68 Book K dated 12th September 1784 “delivered to The Honorable Andrew Pickens Esquire this our Indented Certificate for the Sum of One thousand One hundred and ninety-three pounds twelve Shillings and three pence farthing Sterling for Sundries for Militia Use One thousand Seven hundred Seventy nine, Eighty one and Eighty two [text too faint to discern] pay as Colonel of the Upper Ninety Six District Regiment in One thousand Seven hundred Eighty , Eighty one Eighty two and Eighty three as [text too faint to discern] &c &c”]

[p 8: Reverse of the above Indent bearing endorsements by General Pickens who signature appears as follows:
