[p 2: Printed form of Indent No. 1052 Book Y dated March 22nd, 1785 “delivered to Mr. Thomas Hale this our Indented Certificate, for the Sum of One hundred and Forty three pounds ten shillings Sterling pay as a Sergeant in the 5th Carolina Regiment from 1778 to 1783 as per Account Audited.”]

[pp 3 & 4: Image and retake of image of the reverse of the above Indent. There are no endorsements by the veteran thereon. How the men whose names appear on the reverse of the Indent acquired an interest therein is not disclosed by the documents in this file.]

[Note: This MAY be the same man as [Thomas Hale S37975](#) who also claimed service in the 5th South Carolina Regiment on the Continental Establishment. The reason I have not merged this claim with that veteran’s pension application is that Thomas Hale S37975 did not claim service as a Sergeant and claimed that his time in service expired prior to the fall of Charleston on May 12, 1780.]
