

[p 2: Printed form of Indent No. 10 Book A dated May 11, 1792 “delivered to Mr. Jeremiah Harris this INDENTED CERTIFICATE, for the Sum of Sixty Six Pounds Seventeen Shillings and Nine Pence Sterling being for Pay due him for Fourteen Months and Ten Days Duty as a Private (from the 10<sup>th</sup> November 1781 to 20<sup>th</sup> January 1783) in Colonel Maham’s [Hezekiah Maham’s] Regiment of Cavalry.”]

[p 3: Reverse of the above Indent bearing only the following signature of what I take to be John Black:
