[p 2: Printed form of Indent No. 85 Book K dated September 20, 1784 “delivered to Mr. George Hart this our INDENTED CERTIFICATE for the Sum of thirty five pounds four Shillings and five pence Sterling for pay as a private in the third South Carolina Continental Regiment from the first February One Thousand and Eighty to the last of November Eighty One being twenty-two months per Account Audited &c &c....”]

[p 3: Reverse of the above Indent bearing, among others, the following endorsement:

I do hereby renounce all my right and title & claim to the within, & [undeciphered word] for myself my heirs & Executors, assigns the Same over to Elihu Hall Bay Esquire
