

[p 5: Printed form of Indent No. 493 Book X dated August 25, 1785 “delivered to Mr. William Hollmes, Junr. this our INDENTED CERTIFICATE, for the Sum of Twenty three Pounds, ten Shillings, & four Pence, Stlg. [Sterling] for Duty as a Soldier in an Independent Company commanded by Capt. Tutt [Benjamin Tutt] in 1779 & 1780, as per Account passed by the Commissioners on Accounts.”]
