

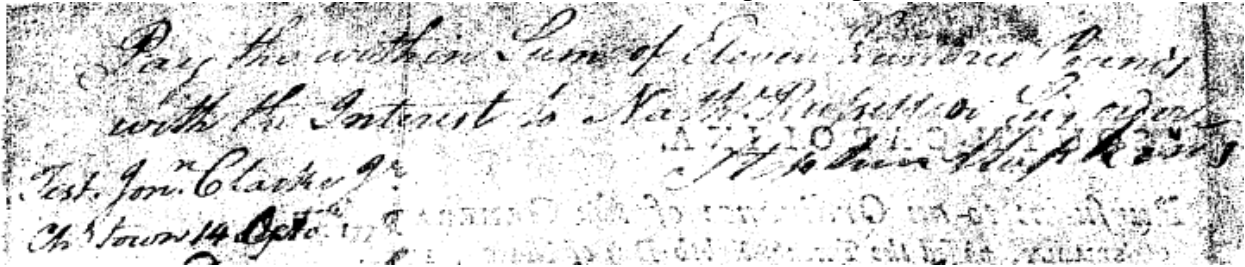

South Carolina Audited Accounts<sup>1</sup> relating to Stephen Hopkins SC4004 pp3  
Audited Account No. 3751A

[p 2: Printed form of Indent No. 150 Book M dated July 22, 1778 whereby the State of South Carolina acknowledges receipt of a loan of £1100 Sterling by "Lieutenant Stephen Hopkins."<sup>2</sup>]

[p 3: Reverse of the above Indent bearing a very faint endorsement which appears to read as follows:

Pay the within Eleven Hundred Pounds with the Interest to Nath<sup>l</sup>. Russell or his order  
Test: Jno<sup>n</sup> Clarke, Jr  
Chs. Town 14 Octo<sup>r</sup> 1778 S/ Stephen Hopkins



[Note: Although this documentation does not prove that a veteran by the name of Stephen Hopkins served as a Lieutenant in any branch of the South Carolina troops during the Revolutionary War, I decided to include it in our database as providing possible evidence of such service.]
