Book X Issued 31 May 1786, to John Howard, for three pounds 17s/1d ½ Stlg. [Sterling] for Duty done in Brandon's [Thomas Brandon's] Regiment per Account audited

Int. £0.2.11

Book O Issued the 25<sup>th</sup> of April 1785, to Mr. John Howard, for Four pounds, eight Shillings & six pence three farthings Stlg [Sterling] for Militia Duty, pr Account Audited.  
Principal £4.8.6 ¾ Annual Interest £0.6.2
