[p 2: Printed form of Indent No. 3809 Book X dated September 25, 1786 “delivered to Mr. James Howerton this our INDENTED CERTIFICATE, for the Sum of Twenty One pounds Sterling [for] duty Done as a Horseman per Account passed by the Commissioners –.”]

[p 3: Reverse of the above Indent bears endorsements by John Fraser and Philip Hart as well as the name of James Howerton. Whether or not the image posted below represents the signature of the veteran, I cannot tell. It appears randomly on the reverse of the Indent and is not associated with any endorsement. It appears as follows:

How Fraser and Hart acquired an interest in this Indent is not disclosed by the documents in this file.]
