

[p 2: Printed form of Indent No. 448 Book N dated April 9, 1785 “delivered to Mr. James Hunt this our INDENTED CERTIFICATE for the Sum of Five Pounds Sterling for 70 Days duty done as a Private in the Militia in 1782 as per Account Audited.”]
