

[p 2: Printed form of Indent No. 122 Book C dated December 23rd 1783 “delivered to Mr. John Hyslop Stewart of the Convalescent Hospital at Haddrell’s Point this our INDENTED CERTIFICATE for the Sum of One Hundred & fifty Six pounds twelve Shillings & Ten Pence Sterling, the Amount of his Pay and Subsistence to the 3rd day of April 1781, as per Certificate from the Auditor General dated the 22nd December 1783.”]
