McDonald’s [probably Archibald McDonald’s]<sup>2</sup> Regiment in 1782 per account Audited.”]

[p 3: Reverse of the above Indent bearing endorsements by Joseph Gourly and Charles Isaac Grimball. How these men acquired an interest in the indent is not disclosed by the documents in this file.]
