

[p 2: Printed form of Indent No. 107 Book H dated July 17th, 1784 “delivered to Mr. John Jordan this our INDENTED CERTIFICATE for the Sum of Four Pounds ten Shillings and eight pence Sterling for Sixty eight days Militia Duty in General Marion’s [Francis Marion’s] Brigade in 1782 per account Audited.”]

[p 3: Reverse of the above Indent bearing , among others, the following endorsement:

This may Certify all Persons To whom it may Concern that I John Jordan have Sold and Delivered unto William Lewis the Within Indent With all the Uses Within Mentioned. Indorsed this the 4th day of November 1784
