

The State of North Carolina macklinburg [Mecklenburg] County  
March 21 1782 then Came John Kass Before the Subscriber a Justice for Sd County and made  
oath as the Law Directs that he Lost In the South Carolina State Service one Black Mare about  
thirteen Hands high for [sic, four] years old and that he Never Received any Satisfaction in part  
or whole for the Same. Sworn before
