[p 2: Printed form of Indent No. 65 Book C dated November 8th, 1783 “delivered to Doctor William Keith Apothecary General Southern Department this our INDENTED CERTIFICATE for the Sum of Five Hundred & Twelve Pounds Seventeen Shillings & four Pence Sterling for his Pay and Subsistence to the 1st day of July 1781 as per Certificate from the Auditor General dated the 7th of November 1783.”]

[p 3: Reverse of the above Indent bearing the following endorsement:

I William Keith, do hereby assign the full Amount of the Principal and Interest now due and which shall become due on the Certificate within Writin [sic, Written?]² to Edward Blake his Executors Administrators or Assigns – having from him the said Edward Blake Received the full Value

this twenty first day of November 1783
