[p 4: Printed form of Indent No. 78 Book Z dated December 18, 1786 “delivered to Mr. Obediah Kendrick this our INDENTED CERTIFICATE, for the Sum of Twelve pounds seventeen Shillings and one pence half penny Sterling for a Horse lost on the Cherokee expedition³ [balance of the text is illegibly faint].]

[pp 5-6: Two images of the reverse of the above Indent each bearing a purported endorsement by the veteran one of which is signed “Obediah Kendrick, O his mark” and the other is signed “Obediah Kendrick, O his mark”.]
