[p 2: Printed form of Indent No. 239 Book N dated February 26<sup>th</sup>, 1785, “delivered to Mr. John Killingsworth this our INDENTED CERTIFICATE for the Sum of Twelve pounds Seventeen Shillings and one penny half penny Sterling for One hundred and five days Militia duty done as a Private in Col. Taylor’s [Thomas Taylor’s] Regiment in 1781 and 1782 per Account audited and Order from His Excellency the Governor &c &c &c”]

I do hereby full my husband myself and our Heirs Executors and administrators assign & make over the within indent to Tho. C. Russell full value received in full this 26 February 1785


