

[p 2: Printed form of Indent No. 101 Book L dated September 24th, 1784 “delivered to Mr. John Leacraft² this our INDENTED CERTIFICATE for the Sum of Ninety four Pounds fourteen Shillings and three Pence Sterling for 219 Days Duty as Captain of the Militia Duty in 1781 as per Account Audited.”]
