

[p 4: Printed form of Indent No. 1436 Book Y dated August 16th, 1786 “delivered to Mr. Thomas Lehre this our INDENTED CERTIFICATE, for the Sum of Seventy pounds four Shillings and One penny Sterling: for pay as Assistant Quarter Master and Rations per account passed by the Commissioners.”]

[p 5: Reverse of the above Indent bearing endorsements by the veteran who signature appears as follows:
