South Carolina Private Samuel McClure SC5326

Note: A private by the name of Samuel McClure is listed in Capt. John Mill's Pay Roll¹ of 10-Month State Troops in Lt. Col. Henry Hampton's Regt of Genl. Thomas Sumter's Brigade. According to Mill's Pay Roll, McClure died having received one grown slave prior to his death sometime prior to Mill's Pay Roll dated March 16, 1782. It is possible that this MAY be the same man as either Samuel McClure [McCluer] SC5224 or Samuel McClure [McCluer] SC5225. Payment in the horrific form of slaves taken from estates of Tories confiscated by Sumter's troops was known as "Sumter's Wages."
