Pension Application of Francis Davis X198

[The file jacket has “Dis,” meaning disability pension, in the place where the file number usually appears. The number X198 is assigned by HeritageQuest. The file contains no original document, but a typed summary states the following:

“You are advised that in a list of pensioners reported by the Secretary of War in 1835, the name of Francis Davis appears as an invalid pensioner who was paid at the Virginia Agency, but whose place of residence could not be ascertained by reason of the destruction of papers in the War Department in 1814. Francis Davis served as private and was paid \$60 per annum from March 4, 1792 under the Act of June 7, 1785.”]
