Pension Application of John Martindale X483

[The file is empty except for correspondence from which the following extract is quoted.]  
“... the list of pensioners reported by the Secretary of War in 1835 shows that one John Martindale served as a Fifer in the Revolutionary Army, and was allowed an invalid pension of \$44.00 per annum from March 4, 1789 under the Act of June 7, 1785, at the Maryland Agency.”
