His name appears on a list of applicants for invalid pensions returned by the District Court for the District of North Carolina submitted to the House of Representatives by the Secretary of War on March 2, 1795 and printed in the American State Papers class 9, page 171.

Rank: Private.

Regt.: Bladen militia.

Disability: Wounded in several places in his back by a small sword, as he was retreating from the enemy.

When and where disabled: June 6, 1781, Rockfish

Residence: Bladen County.

Remarks: Militia.

Evidence complete, excepting that the examining physicians did not state the degree in which the claimant is prevented from obtaining a livelihood by labor.
